The March meeting is scheduled for Thursday March 3rd.

Motion by member Connor and seconded by member Putzier to approve the agenda as proposed with item 8 ii moved to 9 c, the motion carried.

Motion by member Connor and seconded by member Ihrke to approve the proposed meeting minutes from the January meeting, the motion carried.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Connor to approve paying the bills as presented and approving the financial documents as presented, the motion carried.

Clerk report:

- Reviewed staff letters, tagged a car for snow plowing reasons and notice of high-water usage.
- Information from St. Charles and Eyota on election judge reimbursement- found Dover is currently paying on a higher scale than both;

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Connor to leave the city of Dover's pay scale the same for election judges (\$15 head judge and \$12 regular judge), the motion carried.

New Business:

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Putzier to accept the quote submitted by Jim Kieffer to fully tuckpoint and clean the front of the Community Center Building for \$24,000, the motion carried.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Connor to approve an agreement with Donald Millard to continue the Dover brush dump area and agreement for \$500, the motion carried.

Old Business:

Kitchen updates:

- Keep the writing on the wall in the kitchen room as was found under a bulletin board.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Putzier to approve the electrician quote by Bauer Electrotech of Winona to do the work in the proposed kitchen, the motion carried with Mayor Iseminger abstaining.
