

MEETING MINUTES FOR AUGUST 2017

August 3, 2017

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Mayor Ihrke, Jaime Putzier, Melinda Kieffer, Dave Iseminger, John Bushman and Tammy, Devin, Jody and Bruce Wiza, Fred Suhler, Adam Nicklay and Jody Nickelson, Todd Hanenberger, Jim Nigon, Julie Gergen, Brandy Diderrich, Patty Kronebusch, Jim Nigon, Marvin Ihrke, Jill from the St. Charles Press, Ruth Spitzer and Terry Waletzki from the Olmsted County Sheriff's Department. Not present was councilperson Cameron Johnson.

Agenda presented for approval. Motion was made by Jaime Putzier to approve, seconded by Melinda Kieffer. All agreed. Motion carried.

Meeting minutes for July presented for approval. Motion was made by Dave Iseminger to approve, seconded by Jaime Putzier. All agreed. Motion carried.

Bills presented for approval. Motion was made by Melinda Kieffer to approve, seconded by Dave Iseminger. All agreed. Motion carried.

Devin would like to say Thank you to the council for the basketball hoops at the park. He stated that there was a Baptism party or something this last weekend at the Dover Township Hall.

Whoever, putting much trashed the park and some streets with garbage He picked up what he could. The council thanked him for his efforts. Jaime Putzier stated that she will contact the Dover Township Officers about the mess and the alcohol served there.

Julie Gergen and Brandy Diderrich asked about the problem with the fast traffic on South Main Street. We have not met with Mark Welch yet about this matter, but we will shortly.

Officer Waletzki is here to discuss Sheriff's Contract for the City of Dover. There is a 4% increase for 2018 and a 3% increase for 2019. All the contracts were redone. Ours is divided with the City of Eyota. There is one deputy between Eyota and Dover. Mayor Ihrke would like to see a separate contract just for the City of Dover and add 10 more hours. A full time deputy is 42 hours a week. The Sheriff's department will put this together for an additional 10 hours a month. The City is willing to pay for the extra hours, which will be 50 hours per month.

Jim Nigon, representative for the City of Dover's Insurance is here to present the summary for the insurance policy for the next year. Jim exits.

Adam Nicklay and Jody Nickelson who built a new home in Dover, are here to ask the City what can be done with the view of all the boats in the back of TNT Marine. Fence was to be built, but Geoff Griffin stated that trees will be planted this fall behind TNT Marine. The council needs to talk to Geoff Griffin. Todd Hanenberger, owner of TNT Marine, states that all the boats parked there belong to customers and need service repair. Todd stated that he would rather have trees instead of a fence. Todd exits.

Regarding the Sunday Liquor Application for the Shack Bar. The council stated that the City received a copy of the letter that was sent to Jody Wiza from the City Engineer regarding the parking lot behind the business Fred Suhler, attorney for Jody Wiza is asking what the issue is, as to why the Council has not approved the Sunday Liquor License for the Shack Bar? Mayor Ihrke stated that the issue centers around the bar itself, the layout of the business is

totally different than the original submitted plans, the exit/entrance doors, and the concern about a separate entrance for minors, who do frequent for food services and hair services. Jody Wiza stated that she submitted plans to the Cosmetology Agent and was told that separate entrances are not needed. The City of Dover is requesting the separate entrances. The councils concern is that hair services are being done in the food and alcohol areas. People getting any hair services need to be in a separate area. Where people drink is also important. Furthermore, the City of Dover has not received anything from the Cosmetology Agent. Jody stated that they are separated. Jody stated that she had CMS come down and look at the patio. The occupancy number for inside the building is 42.

Fred Suhler stated that the City of Dover has not yet done anything to reprimand Jody Wiza.

Dave Iseminger, Melinda Kieffer and Jaime Putzier have an issue with being mis-lead by Jody Wiza.

Be it noted that the exit to the back of the Shack Bar goes to the patio. There is no exit from the patio out, one needs to go back thru the bar area. If the capacity is 100 or more, then there needs to be an exit door in the back. Motion was made by Jaime Putzier to approve, seconded by David Iseminger. All agreed. Motion carried.

Dave Iseminger stated that the City does not want any people on the patio or the deck until completed and approved.

A motion was made by Dave Iseminger to table the Sunday Liquor License for the Shack Bar until the September council meeting, seconded by Melinda Kieffer. All agreed. Motion carried.

Mayor Ihrke stated that the Sunday Liquor License was denied at this point because of violations at the Shack Bar, that is what the hearing is for.

Jody Wiza states that she is concerned about the patio at the Neighbors Pub.

There will be a separate violations hearing for two liquor establishments in Dover:

- 1) Road Trip Bar and Grill, Wednesday, September 6, 2017 at 6:00 P.M.
- 2) The Shack Bar, Wednesday, September 6, 2017 at 8:00 P.M.

The Council needs to develop resolutions regarding the violations.

There is no word on the Dover School purchase yet.

The computer for the City has been rebuilt by Mr. James Strand.

Nothing on the transit bus.

Melinda Kieffer stated that the Dover Summer Recreation group will be going to Valley Fair on August 4, 2017. There are 15 people signed up and a van will be rented from Kuehn Motors in Rochester.

People with dangerous dog are constructing the fence for the dog. Not completed yet. A reminder letter will be sent and they will be asked to attend the continued meeting.

A motion was made by Melinda Kieffer to continue this meeting on Monday, August 14, 2017 at the Dover City Hall at 7:00 P.M.

Motion was seconded by Dave Iseminger. All agreed. Motion carried.

August 14, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. CONTINUED MEETING

Present were Mayor Ihrke, Jaime Putzier, Dave Iseminger, Cameron Johnson, Melinda Kieffer, Patty Kronebusch, Ruth Spitzer and Marvin Ihrke.

Melinda Kieffer gave the clerk cash from the Valley Fair Trip. This was from chaperones and outside kids who attended.

Discussed correspondence from Attorney Suhler and the correspondence with Jody Wiza of the Shack Bar.

The council reviewed the State Statues for what can be sold in a liquor establishment #340A.412

Resolutions of the violations for the The Road Trip Bar and Grill, and Jody Wiza were presented for adoption. Motion was made by Melinda Kieffer to approve, seconded by Jaime Putzier. All agreed. Mayor Ihrke abstained from voting. Motion carried. A copy of these will be sent to the owners.

The council agreed that the two hearings be held at the Dover Community Center on Wednesday, September 6, 2017. The Road Trip Bar and Grill hearing will be held at 6:00 P.M. The hearing for Jody Wiza will be held 7:00 P.M.

Renteria's, who have the potentially dangerous dog, entered the meeting. They are here to pay the \$300.00 fee to the City. We told them to wait until they delivered to us a copy of the insurance for the dog. They had a chip installed in the dog and they need to put a

lock on the gate. They are in the process of looking for insurance. They will be back at the September 7, 2017 meeting.

Cameron Johnson presented a letter that the City of Dover received stating that Peoples Energy Coop is looking for volunteers for their Board. We will place the information on the Dover Website for anybody interested.

Jaime Putzier presents the council with the log from Semcac for the transit bus. Mike Rizzo will be leaving Semcac.

Regarding the Stop signs on South Main Street and South Street, the City will be ordering and erecting 2 more stop signs at that intersection, which will make it a 4 way stop. A motion was made by Cameron Johnson to approve, seconded by Jaime Putzier. All agreed except Mayor Ihrke, motion carried.

A letter needs to be sent to the homeowners on South Main St regarding disabled and unlicensed vehicles parked on their property and on the street. They need to be removed.

The updated Sheriffs Contract with Olmsted County was presented for approval. 10 extra hours will be added. A motion was made by Dave Iseminger to approve, seconded by Jaime Putzier. All agreed. Motion carried.

With no further business, Jaime Putzier made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Dave Iseminger. All agreed. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:39 P.M.
