

MEETING MINUTES FOR JULY 2014

July 10, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Doug Peterson as Acting Mayor in Mayor Ihrke's absence, Jaime Putzier, Matt Elder, Aaron Nicklay, Marvin Ihrke, John and Pam Engrave, Crystal Merchelwitz, Jamie Wilson, Nathan Campbell from St. Charles Press, Brian Todd from the Rochester Post Bulletin.

Agenda presented for approval. Motion was made by Matt Elder to approve, seconded by Aaron Nicklay. All agreed. Motion carried.

Minutes from June 2014 meeting presented for approval. Motion was made by Aaron Nicklay, seconded by Matt Elder. All agreed. Motion carried.

Bills were presented for approval. Motion was made by Aaron Nicklay, seconded by Jaime Putzier. All agreed.

John and Pam Engrave presented the council with the fact that their boulevard is now just rock and gravel. John stated that he put his money back into it right away, Ruskell Lawn Care tore it back up. The City did reimburse Engraves for their efforts. The City stated that Ruskell Lawn Service will be contacted.

Crystal Merchelwitz and Jamie Wilson presented the council with information regarding a second dog bite from a neighbors dog, this time it was Jamie Wilsons son. They also reported that another little girl went on the dog owner's property and got bit. This is 3 bites in 2 months. There will be a hearing with the dog owners at the August 7, 2014 council meeting. Crystal asked again about

updating the dog ordinance.

Certified letters need to be sent to 2 Dover residents about removing obstructions on their boulevards within 30 days. This will be at the homeowners expense. It is the homeowners responsibility to know where their property lines are.

A new street sign is needed at the intersection of 6th Street and County Road #10. Mayor Ihrke will take care of that. Regarding the complaint about a bump at that intersection, this will be taken care of when the final lift of blacktop is done on 6th Street.

Letter sent and received regarding the removal of tires on personal property.

A Certified letter needs to be sent to property owner in City Limits who have been reported as to burning garbage on their property. This is not allowed in the City.

Mr. & Mrs. David Hander are presented and are concerned about the problem with no drainage of water on the east side of the property. Doug stated that this is not a City Issue.

A business is interested in locating to Dover and would put up a new structure. Mayor Ihrke is checking with the City's attorney regarding a TIF district.

The pot hole next to the alley by Aaron Nicklay's property still has not been repaired. Mayor Ihrke needs to talk to the City Maintenance worker.

A motion was made by Matt Elder to approve Dave Iseminger as a new member of the Dover Fire Department, seconded by Aaron Nicklay. All agreed.

Aaron Nicklay reported on the success of the Pedal Pull held on the Fourth of July. 41 children registered to participate. Also stated the Fireworks held on July 3 were a success as well.

2 people from the council are being asked to attend the Committee Regional Housing meeting for Olmsted County on Wednesday, July 23, 2014 from 4:00 to 7:00 P.M.

A Thank You letter needs to be sent to Deb Brossard for the donation of the Elliptical Machine to the Community Work Out Center.

With no further business, a motion was made by Matt Elder to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Aaron Nicklay. All agreed. Motion carried.
