

## **MAY 2013 CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

**May 2, 2013**

**The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Mayor Ihrke, Michelle Danielson, Matt Elder, Aaron Nicklay, Doug Peterson, Marvin Ihrke, Mark Welch from GGG, and Michelle Amundson.**

**Meeting agenda was presented.**

**Minutes from the April meeting were presented for approval. Motion was made by Aaron Nicklay to approve, seconded by Doug Peterson. All agreed. Motion carried.**

**Board of Equalization meeting minutes were presented for approval. Motion was made by Doug Peterson to approve, seconded by Matt Elder. All agreed. Motion carried.**

**Bills were presented for approval. Motion was made by Doug Peterson to approve, seconded by Michelle Peterson. All agreed. Motion carried.**

**Mark Welch from GGG presents the bid for the lift on 5<sup>th</sup> Way of \$78.00/ton and 6<sup>th</sup> Court of \$69.15/ton from Rochester Sand and Gravel. Regarding the end of 6<sup>th</sup> St., this would be a crushed rock turnable hammerhead turnaround.**

**Mark would like a motion by the council to allow Rochester Sand and Gravel to put the 2<sup>nd</sup> lifts on 6<sup>th</sup> Court, 5<sup>th</sup> Way, and the corner of 6<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> to tie into the catch basin. The estimated start date of this project could be as early as June 1, 2013. A motion was made by Doug Peterson to approve this work order for the cost of approximately \$40,000.00. Motion was seconded by Matt Elder. All agreed. Motion carried.**

**Be it noted that the South part of Main and 6<sup>th</sup> Street remains to be completed.**

**Regarding the County Road #10 project, Mark is aware that the boulevards need to be reseeded, and the sidewalks reviewed for damages from the first reseeding effort. The traffic plan for the work on County Road #10, North of the railroad tracks to Highway #14 is that one lane would be done at a time, which would leave the road open for traffic.**

**Michelle Amundson discusses the plans for Dover Summer Recreation in 2013. The program will run from June 10, 2013 thru July 25, 2013. Events will be pretty much the same as other years, but soccer will be tried this year and T-Ball will be in the evenings. Purchases will be 2 soccer nets and balls, approximate costs from \$80.00 to \$120.00. Michelle stated that there may be a canoe trip again this year along with the Valley Fair Trip. She stated that she needs 2 employees to help with the program. A motion was made by Aaron Nicklay to approve the Summer Rec Program for 2013**

**as presented, motion was seconded by Michelle Danielson. All agreed. Motion carried.**

**Discussion on a residential property in the City of Dover that needs to be cleaned up along with garbage removed from the premises. A certified letter will be sent to them with a time line to clean up their property.**

**The house on the property owned by Tim Todd will be burned down by the Dover Fire Department because of the previous fire damage.**

**Aaron Nicklay presented the schedule for the ball park. Friday evenings , Sunday evenings and Sunday afternoons will be Youth Softball Practice. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings will be league softball. This schedule will be posted on the Dover Website. Aaron stated the disclaimer is that to the best of our knowledge we do not settle any conflicts. The local Snowmobile Club made a \$1,000.00 donation to the City Ball Park.**

**Mayor Ihrke attended the FEMA meeting regarding the new mapping system.**

**A letter will be sent to a local dog owner about his dog running at large within his neighborhood.**

**There are dogs being sheltered in a horse trailer at a former business in town. The owner will be approached on this issue.**

**Signs have been posted by the retention pond stating no Motorcycles or ATVs on the property. Signs have also been posted on the streets in the industrial park area stating there is to be no semi-parking. The council discussed the issue of semi-parking on the streets in Dover. The ordinance will be reviewed and updated if necessary.**

**Matt Elder, who is on the Dover- Eyota St. Charles Sewer District board, stated that the MPCA and the EDA tested the nitrogen level limits at the plant. They are now .01 and they would like to see them at 0.**

**The intersection in Eyota at Highway 14 and 42 is being updated for safety. They will now have flashing LED lights on the stop signs, rumble strips and paint a portion of the roads approaching the intersection to alert the public.**

**The light for the Dover Sign parallel to Highway 14 is out. Mayor Ihrke will get a price on a new LED light.**

**With no further business, a motion was made by Doug Peterson to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Matt Elder. All agreed. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:08 P.M.**
