

## City of Dover Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes May 2, 2024

The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Dover City Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Dave Iseminger in the City Hall as posted.

Present were Mayor Dave Iseminger, Council Members Jaime Putzier, Eric Tyler and Chelsie Kiekbusch. Absent- Jodi Nicklay. Staff present Gary Pedersen, Clerk/Treasurer, Marvin Ihrke, Water Supervisor. Others in attendance: Deputy Adam Waletzki, Janet Scofield, Jody and Bruce Wiza, Dustin Bell, and Commissioner Brian Mueller.

Motion by Member Putzier and seconded by Member Tyler to approve the agenda as presented, the motion carried.

Citizen items:

Janet Scofield addressed the council and would like to have an option for food trucks to be able to plug into the community center with 220/50-amp services. Discussion took place on the need.

Motion by Member Kiekbusch and seconded by Member Tyler to add a 50-amp service for the community center, the motion carried.

Deputy Waletzki- complaints on dogs not on leashes on Main Street near the post office.

Sheriff's Office will recommend to City of Dover to not approve liquor licenses beyond 1:00 AM in the future.

Dustin Bell discussed "car show" time for July 6<sup>th</sup>- will be 9 AM to 1 PM for the awards.

Mayor Iseminger will talk to garden tractor pullers to see if they can hold off to start until 1 PM if possible.

Clerk Report:

Motion by Member Tyler and seconded by Member Kiekbusch to approve the meeting minutes as presented for the last regular meeting, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Kiekbusch and seconded by Member Tyler to approve the meeting minutes for the April Closed Session of the Council addressing land sale by the city, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Tyler and seconded by Member Kiekbusch to pay the bills and approve the financials as presented, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Putzier and seconded by Member Tyler to allow up to \$8,900 to reduce the height of the chimney on the NW corner of the community center roof, the motion carried.

New Business:

Motion by Member Kiekbusch and seconded by Member Putzier to transfer \$17,071.60 to the fire department account for yearly services of the department to the city, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Tyler and seconded by Member Kiebusch to approve the proposed metes and bounds for lots 7 & 8 from lots 5 & 6 (tennis courts) of Sheeks Addition for the purpose of selling lots 7 & 8, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Kiebusch and seconded by Member Tyler to approve the request by Neighbor's Bar for special events on May 18 for cook off and July 4<sup>th</sup> for annual chicken feed, the motion carried with conditions as listed on applications.

Motion by Member Tyler and seconded by Member Kiebusch to approve the request by Shack Bar for special event on July 3<sup>rd</sup> with a band on the patio, the motion carried with conditions as listed on application.

Old Business:

Digital Radar Discussion.

Motion by Member Tyler and seconded by Member Putzier to approve up to \$3,133 to purchase a digital radar system for county road 10 on the south of the city, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Kiebusch and seconded by Member Putzier to "waive the tort limit" for the city insurance provided by the LMC, the motion carried.

Council Members:

Troy Badker turned down the appointment on the organized garbage collection committee.

Motion by Member Putzier and seconded by Member Tyler to appoint Dan Bolton to the organized garbage collection committee, the motion carried.

Discussion on planting trees at the city park to replace the dead ones we had to remove.

Motion by Member Putzier and seconded by Member Kiebusch to adjourn the regular meeting at 9:15 PM, motion carried.
