

City of Dover Meeting Minutes June 3, 2021

June 3, 2021

The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Dover City Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Dave Iseminger in City Hall as posted.

Present were Mayor Dave Iseminger, Council Members Jaime Putzier, Chelsie Kiekbusch and Roger Ihrke City Clerk/Treasurer Gary Pedersen, Water Superintendent Marvin Ihrke; absent- Kevin Connor. Others in attendance: Jim Nigon- Heartman Agency.

The July meeting is scheduled for Thursday July 1st.

Motion by member Kiekbusch and seconded by member Putzier to approve the agenda as proposed, the motion carried.

Jim Nigon of Heartman Insurance reviewed the Cities insurance rates, history and the proposed policy from the League of MN Insurance Trust for the coming year.

Motion by member Putzier and seconded by member Kiekbusch to “waive the tort limit” for the insurance policy for the coming year, the motion carried.

Motion by member Putzier and seconded by Mayor Iseminger to approve the May meeting minutes as presented, the motion carried.

Motion by member Putzier and seconded by member Kiekbusch to approve the financial statements and the proposed list of bills to be paid for the past month, the motion carried.

Motion by member Putzier and seconded by Mayor Iseminger to approve the special event permit applied for by Neighbors Pub for July 3rd and 4th, with usual conditions, the motion carried.

Discussion took place about: trees planted near the warehouse, removal of trees from park and drain covers that need to be lowered around the city.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Putzier to accept a \$7,400 quote to remove the park trees from integrity tree service, unless a lower quote may be obtained by the same person that will be removing trees as part of the street project on park circle, the motion carried.

Motion by member Putzier and seconded by member Kiekbusch to close streets in conjunction with the pedal pull behind the firehall and the fireworks both on July 3rd. For the fireworks that includes South St W and Pleasant St S on each side of the ball field from morning until the events end; the pedal pullers will include Park Avenue West by the firehall and city park, the motion carried.

The Millard family has requested to subdivide their property while settling the estate.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Putzier to allow the subdivision, the part in the city that is south of highway 14 is floodplain, the remainder part of the farm is north of highway 14 and will be owned separately from the land south of highway 14, the motion carried.

Council updates included discussions and directed letters to be sent to residents concerning: un-mowed lawns/weeds, junk and parking into the alley with obstruction.

A motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Putzier to adjourn at 8:05 PM, the motion carried.
