

## City of Dover Meeting Minutes July 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2021

The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Dover City Council was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Dave Iseminger in City Hall as posted.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Putzier to approve the agenda as proposed, the motion carried.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Connor to approve the last months meeting minutes as proposed, the motion carried.

Clerk report:

3. Discussed putting up street closed signs for the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July celebrations
4. Update on applications for possible grants for the proposed kitchen.
5. Tree removal from the park will be done in the next month.

7. Almost all the fire hydrants in the city have been freshly painted.

Motion by member Putzier and seconded by member Ihrke to accept the repair quote from Griffin Construction on the manhole covers as listed on the bid, the motion carried.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Connor to adopt and approve a resolution offered to accept and apply for the local fiscal recover fund (ARPA), the motion carried.

Motion by member Connor and seconded by member Putzier to approve a donation to the Evergreen Cemetery of \$1,500, the motion carried.

Motion by member Ihrke and seconded by member Connor for the approval of Ben Badker to join the Dover Volunteer Fire department as a member, the motion carried.

Council updates included discussions on responses to complaint letters sent out last month.

Marvin Ihrke gave an update on the well and its repairs- hoping to get it all resolved in the near future- it is running and pumping but only manually at this time.

Mayor Iseminger presented past Mayor Ihrke with a plaque and cake to celebrate his services to the city over the years as Mayor- THANK YOU ROGER!!
