

City of Dover Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes November 3, 2022

The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Dover City Council was called to order at 7:05 PM by Acting-Mayor Jaime Putzier in City Hall as posted.

Present were Acting-Mayor Jaime Putzier, Council Members Chelsie Kiekbusch, Roger Ihrke and Kevin Connor. Absent- Mayor Dave Iseminger,. Staff in attendance were: Gary Pedersen, Clerk/Treasurer and Marvin Ihrke Water Superintendent. Others in attendance: Ross and Joan Flury, Doug Wigham and Scott from M & M Construction.

A Variance request that was advertised to hold a public hearing on behalf of the Flury's was cancelled due to them changing their application to meet ordinance standards no longer requiring a variance.

Quotes for snow plowing the city of dover streets for 2022-2023; 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 were opened for review. Two quotes were received from M & M Construction and Wigham Trucking. The Council reviewed the two quotes, asked questions of the two contractors who were both present. Discussed hauling snow away from main street, the cul-de-sacs and by the fire hall. Noted M & M ownership is in the process of changing and the new owner will honor the agreement if offered for the three years at the prices submitted by M & M.

Motion by Member Connor and seconded by Member Kiekbusch to accept the quote from M & M Construction for a three-year agreement to plow the city streets as set forth in the advertisement placed in the official city appointed newspaper, the motion carried 4-0 vote.

Motion by Member Ihrke and seconded by Member Connor to approve the agenda as presented, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Connor and seconded by Member Kiekbusch to approve the October meeting minutes as presented, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Ihrke and seconded by Member Connor to approve the financials and pay the bills as presented for the prior month, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Ihrke and seconded by Member Kiekbusch to accept the quote from SE Mechanical of Chatfield to connect the natural gas to the new generator at the well, the motion carried.

Motion by Member Ihrke and seconded by Member Connor to approve the 2023 liquor license and a 2 AM closing for the Road Trip Bar and Grill, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Member Ihrke and seconded by Member Connor to approve the 2023 liquor license for the Neighbors Pub, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Member Ihrke and seconded by Member Kiekbusch to approve the 2023 liquor license for the Shack Bar, the motion carried unanimously.

Setting up for “pickleball” in the gym for the winter- talked about having certain nights for residents to learn how and enjoy the game as part of the community center events.
