To the first installment shall be added interest on the entire assessment from the date of this resolution until December 31, 2012. To each subsequent installment, when due, shall be added interest for one year on all unpaid installments. Motion was made by Jerome Dyba to approve, seconded by Aaron Nicklay. All agreed. Motion carried.

NOVEMBER MEETING MINUTES

Minutes were presented for approval. Corrections were made and a motion from Aaron Nicklay was made to approve, seconded by Teresa Hackler. All agreed. Motion carried.

Bills were presented for approval. Motion was made by Aaron Nicklay to approve, seconded by Michelle Danielson. All agreed. Motion carried.

The City received the Fema Payment in the total amount of \$12,066.57.

Mayor Ihrke stated that the old Fire Truck was sold for \$4,750.00 to Ironwood Contracting in Northern Minnesota.

Time to open the snowplowing bids for the late winter of 2012 and early 2013 for the City of Dover. The only one received was from Marvin Ihrke Construction in Dover, MN. 55929. His bid was for \$78.00/hour for the streets and the alleys. Equipment list and proof of insurance

were provided. Motion was made by Jerome Dyba to approve, seconded by Teresa Hackler. All agreed. Motion carried.

Update on County Road #10. This project will not close out in 2012. The final lift will not go on until 2013, along with the length of road of County Rd #10 from the railroad tracks (heading north towards Hwy #14) to Highway #14, and the seeding. The storm drains will function properly when the final lift is installed. Any large amount of water will be caught. Mark Welch from GGG Cubed will come to the December meeting and present in writing the fact that this project will not be done until 2013.

The City will proceed with the application for 2004A GO Bond refinancing.

There is still Semi-Parking on Residential streets in Dover. The City may consider an ordinance possibly by next spring. This issue will be tabled until January 2013.

With no further business, a motion was made by Jerome Dyba to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Michelle Danielson. All agreed. Meeting adjourned at 7:40 P.M.
