

SPECIAL MEETING HELD

The owners of the dog will be notified by a certified mail of the decision of the council along with the requirements that need to be met.

Vicki Koehler and Mrs. Kieffer state that they have been having problems with a neighbor dog running at large through their neighborhood. A friendly dog, but pesty and makes his mess in surrounding yards. They

would like a letter sent to the owners along with the ordinance in the City explaining that their dog cannot run at large.

Discussion on the purchase of a truck for the City. It was recommended by the Mayor that we find something used for under \$15,000.00. Matt Elder and Michelle Danielson expressed that they would rather not purchase a use pickup. Matt Elder made a motion to put out a bid for a 2012 or a 2013 ¾ ton pickup to be set up for snowplowing, motion was seconded by Michelle Danielson. All agreed. Motion carried. Mayor Ihrke will write up and put out the bid.
