

SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES FROM JULY 28 2015

July 28, 2015

Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M. Present were Matt Elder, Jaime Putzier, Melinda Kieffer, Dave Iseminger, Jill from the St. Charles Press, Crystal Merchlewitz. Not present was Mayor Ihrke. Matt Elder will be acting Mayor for this meeting.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss and decide if two dogs, a Rat Terrier named Roxy and a Bit Pull named Deuce, after being involved in an incident on June 27, 2015, will be declared either Potentially Dangerous dogs, or Dangerous dogs. The owner, who was mailed a certified letter, and signed for it, was asked to be present at this meeting, is not here.

The report from the Olmsted County Sheriffs office was read to the council and the attendees, along with the State Statues defining the Potentially Dangerous dog, and a Dangerous Dog.

Dave Iseminger spoke with the owner, and he stated that he found a new home for the 2 dogs, out of Olmsted County.

The City of Dover still needs to adhere to the State Statues and do the paperwork as required upon their decision.

A motion was made by Dave Iseminger to declare both the Rat Terrier named Roxy and the Bit Pull named Deuce, Dangerous dogs, motion was seconded by Jaime Putzier. All agreed. Motion carried.

A letter will be sent to the owner of notification of the council's decision, along with the requirements that have to be met. A copy of this letter will be forwarded to the Olmsted County Sheriff's office.

A motion was made by Melinda Kieffer to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Jaime Putzier. All agreed. Motion carried.
